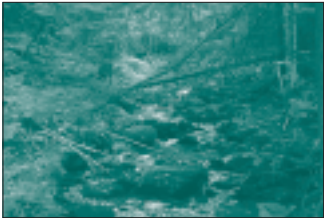
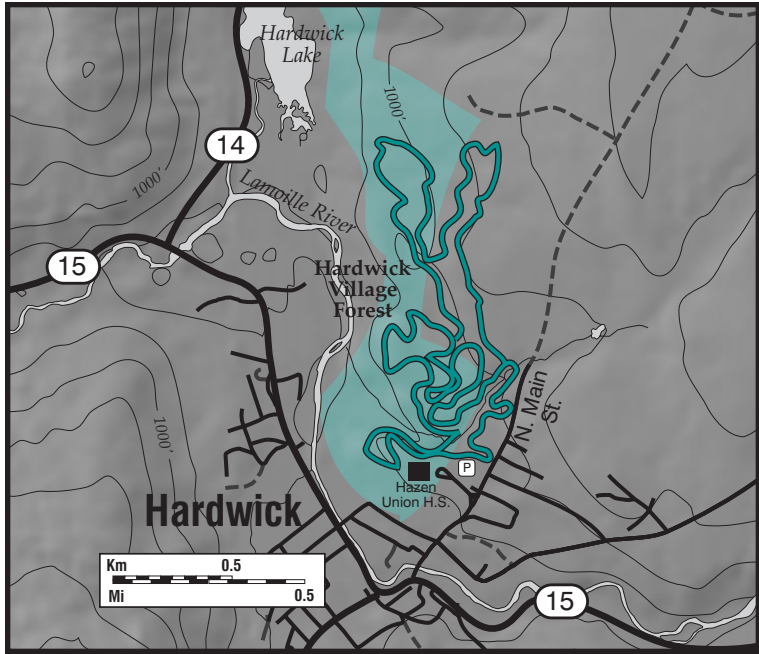


M - Hardwick Trails



Hardwick Trails were conceived and constructed by the Orleans Southwest Supervisory Union in 2002-2003 with funding from the Vermont Department of Forests, Parks and Recreation as a multi-use trail and is open for public use. This easy cross country trail explores some of Hardwick's scenic northern mixed

forest and is accessed from the Hazen Union High School parking lot. Divided into two 3 mile loops abundantly blazed with either yellow (Forestry Trail that starts at the parking lot) or blue (Shepard's Trail that branches off the northeast corner of the Forestry Trail), Hardwick Trails offer a pleasant wooded walk though they are still a bit fresh and muddy in places. Keep an eye out for occasional signposts bearing select poetry!
